Directions to Comfort Inn & Suites:

From Bryan/College Station take Highway 6 South approx. 28 miles, then Exit Highway 105/90 to Brenham/Anderson. Left at intersection, go under Highway 6 and take a right. Stay on two-way frontage road, and hotel will be ¾ mile on left hand side behind Mallett Brothers BBQ. Yield to exit ramp.

From Houston/Austin take Highway 290 to Hempstead, Exit Highway 6 North to Bryan/College Station approx. 20 miles. Exit highway 105 to Conroe, go straight through intersection @ Hwy 105. Stay on frontage road; hotel is 1 mile on the right behind Mallett Brothers BBQ.

Directions to Washington-on-the-Brazos and Star of the Republic Museum:

From Brenham take Hwy. 105 east 14 miles, turn right on FM 912 to Washington-on-the-Brazos State Historical Park.

From Navasota/Comfort Inn & Suites take Hwy 105 west 7 miles, turn left on FM 1155 to Washington-on-the-Brazos State Historical Park.

From Austin take Hwy 290 east straight into Brenham. Turn left onto Hwy. 105 near Blinn College. Continue on Hwy 105 east through town. Continue on Hwy 105 about 20 miles to FM 912. Veer to the right, and continue going straight until you come to the Park entrance.

From Houston take Hwy 290 to Hwy 6 at Hempstead. Turn right on Hwy 6 to Navasota. Take Hwy 105 west 7 miles, turn left on FM 1155 to Washington-on-the-Brazos State Historical Park.

<u>Directions from Comfort Inn & Suites to Navasota Center/Banquet Hall:</u>

Start out going North on Highway 6 N toward Tx-90/Washington ST. Turn Left onto Tx-105 / TX-90 / E Washington St. Turn Left onto Tx-6-BR / S La Salle St.
